### Features

<b>Air Conditioning</b>	Driver's cab air-conditioning operates only when the engine is running.
<b>Heating</b>	A portable heater can be rented for the living area and only operates when plugged in at a campground. (must be requested and subject to availability)
<b>Kitchen</b>	Refrigerator 40L — 12V/240V 2 burner alcohol stove Microwave (240V) Pots, Pans, Cutlery, Crockery, Cleaning utensils
<b>Sink</b>	Stainless steel sink
<b>Water tank</b>	Capacity is 40 litres. It is recommended to fill this tank daily. Water hose is provided. (Cold water)
<b>Greywater</b>	Capacity is 40 Litres
<b>Power supply</b>	12V battery/240V mains power. 240V power sockets. Lights run on 12V.
<b>Entertainment</b>	AM/FM Radio and CD Player
<b>Seat belts</b>	3 belts in the driver cab
<b>Fire extinguisher</b>	Supplied
<b>Sleeping Kit</b>	Linen, Pillows, Duvets
<b>Storage</b>	Storage area under benches. We recommend soft luggage as space is limited.
<b>Child seats</b>	Not available - No anchor point in vehicle

### Insurance

All campervan bookings come with basic insurance and an excess liability of \$3500. We have a number of options to further reduce this excess which will be included in your quote.

Available for an additional cost: GPS, Heater, Outdoor Chair, Outdoor Table, Tyre chains (must be requested and subject to availability)



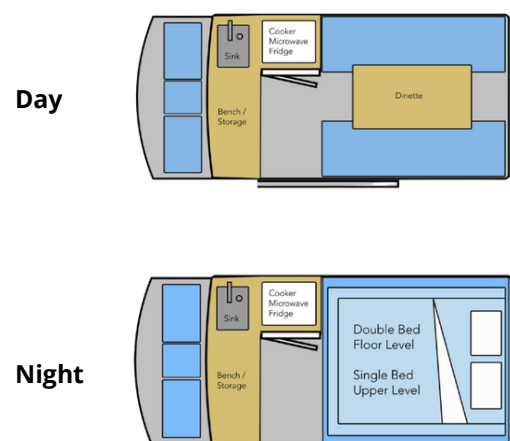
### Additional Information

Airbags on driver and passenger side.

Personal package (included with vehicle) - towels, sheets, sleeping bags, tea towels, linen.

The campervan power will last up to 24 hours when fully charged. Campervans are recommended to stay at powered sites every evening unless the campervan is driven continuously for 7 hours per day, which will charge the battery enough to be with sufficient power for 24 hours without 240V power. To operate 240V power sockets, the van must be connected to 240V power supply.
